DR. LUDWIG FINK,

85, a psychiatrist at the Woodburn Community Mental Health Center in Falls Church who also had worked at St. Elizabeths Hospital and the Fauquier County Mental Health Center, died of congestive heart failure Feb. 17 at his home in Fairfax.

Dr. Fink was born in Berlin. He earned his medical degree at the University of Turin, Italy, and practiced in Iran before coming to this

country in 1947.

He settled in Syracuse, N.Y., where he qualified to practice psychiatry in this country, and made a career with the New York State Health Department. He was assistant director of the Dannemora (N.Y.) State Prison Hospital, where he worked for about 10 years before moving to the Washington area

about 1971. Dr. Fink was on the staffs of St. Elizabeths and the Fauquier center in the early 1970s, and had worked at the Woodburn center since com-

ing here. He was a member of the Amer-

ican Psychiatric Association and the Fairfax Rotary Club.

His wife, Elfriede Fink, died in 1968. Survivors include one son, Thomas Fink of Falls Church; one sister, Hilda Weissenberg of the Bronx, N.Y., and two grandchildars. dren.
