S: PT REPORTS CHEST PAIN 0/10 AT PRESENT, STATES PAIN COMES AND GOES WITH THE WORST PAIN 8/10 WHILE SITTING ON BUNK. PT INDICATES WITH HAND THAT HIS LEFT SIDE HURTS. ASKED PT TO INDICATE WITH ONE FINGER WHERE PAIN WAS LOCATED. PT POINTED TO LEFT SIDE 5TH INTERCOSTAL SPACE AT THE STERNAL BORDER AND MIDCLAVICULAR LEVELS. PT REPORTS PAIN IS "LIKE A KNIFE". STATES PAIN BEGAN 2 HOURS AGO. ASKED PT WHEN HE LAST ATE PT REPLIED "2 HOURS AGO, A PEANUT BUTTER SANDWICH." PT STATES THAT HE THOUGHT PAIN WAS INDIGESTION AND TOOK 2 RANITIDINE WITHOUT RELIEF. DENIES RECENT EXERCISE OR HEAVY LIFTING, DENIES PAIN ON PALPATION OF CHEST. LAST BM THIS AM "NORMAL" STATES HE DRINKS A LOT OF WATER AND EATS RAISINS TO HELP HAVE A NORMAL BM. REPORTS THAT HE VOMITED X1 YESTERDAY AND X 2 THE DAY BEFORE.
