A review of this case indicates no unreported activity of subject. The last activity was the 1965 performance of art work for "Free Student", self-described as a publication of the May 2 Movement (M2M). In 1964, subject participated in a trip to Cuba sponsored by Student Committee For Travel to Cuba. Subject participated in demonstrations sponsored by M2M and PLP 12/64 and 1/65.

Subject has resided in Italy since January, 1967 and married an Italian insurance agent in December, 1967. He is a member of the Italian Communist Party.

In view of subject's lack of activity in this country since 1965, it is recommended she be deleted from the SI. If the deletion is authorized, a stop will be placed with INS in the event subject returns to the US.
