The files of the Passport Office, United States Department of State, Washington, D. C., reviewed on June 9, 1961, disclosed that Susan Elisabeth Rotolo was issued passport number B135413 on February 14, 1961, at New York City for proposed travel abroad of one year to Italy, France and England for the stated purpose of travel and study.

This passport is valid for three years from date of issuance for travel in all countries except Albania, Cuba, and those portions of China, Korea and Vietnam under communist control.

In her passport application dated February 13, 1961, at New York City, Rotolo stated that she intended to depart from the port of New York on approximately March 21, 1961, aboard the ship "Crnagora." She indicated that she would also return by ship. She stated that she was not traveling in an organized tour and had made no trips abroad during the preceding twelve months.

Rotolo listed her birth date as November 20, 1943, at New York City. A notation on the passport application reflected that she presented a copy of her birth certificate as verification of the above date.

Rotolo listed her permanent residence and mailing address as 21-13 79th Street, Jackson Heights 70, New York, and requested that in the event of death or accident her
